Last week, Anna went on a day trip. All the students in her class visited the local country park.

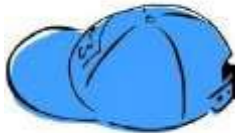
First they went to the café and had a drink and some lovely homemade lemon cakes.
