Going to the dentist

Who needs a check-up?

Most people need a check-up every six months. The dentist can then see if there are any problems and can advise how to keep a healthy mouth.

What does the dentist do during the check-up?

- Looks at your teeth, gums and mouth
- Asks about your general health
- Asks about any problems with your teeth, mouth or gums
- Gives advice about cleaning your teeth
- Discusses the time for your next appointment.

How often do you need a dental check-up?

The dentist will give you a date for your next visit. This can be from three months to eighteen months. It depends on how healthy your teeth and gums are.

What about dental treatment?

When you have a check-up, the dentist may clean and polish your teeth. If the dentist finds problems with your teeth you may need a filling or have to have a tooth taken out.

How much will it cost?

This depends on whether you go to a NHS dentist or a private one. If you're on **a low income** or benefits, you may be able to get help with your NHS dental treatment.

You pay one charge for each complete course of treatment, and the courses are divided into three bands. Band 1 is £18.50, Band 2 is £50.50 and Band 3 is £219.


