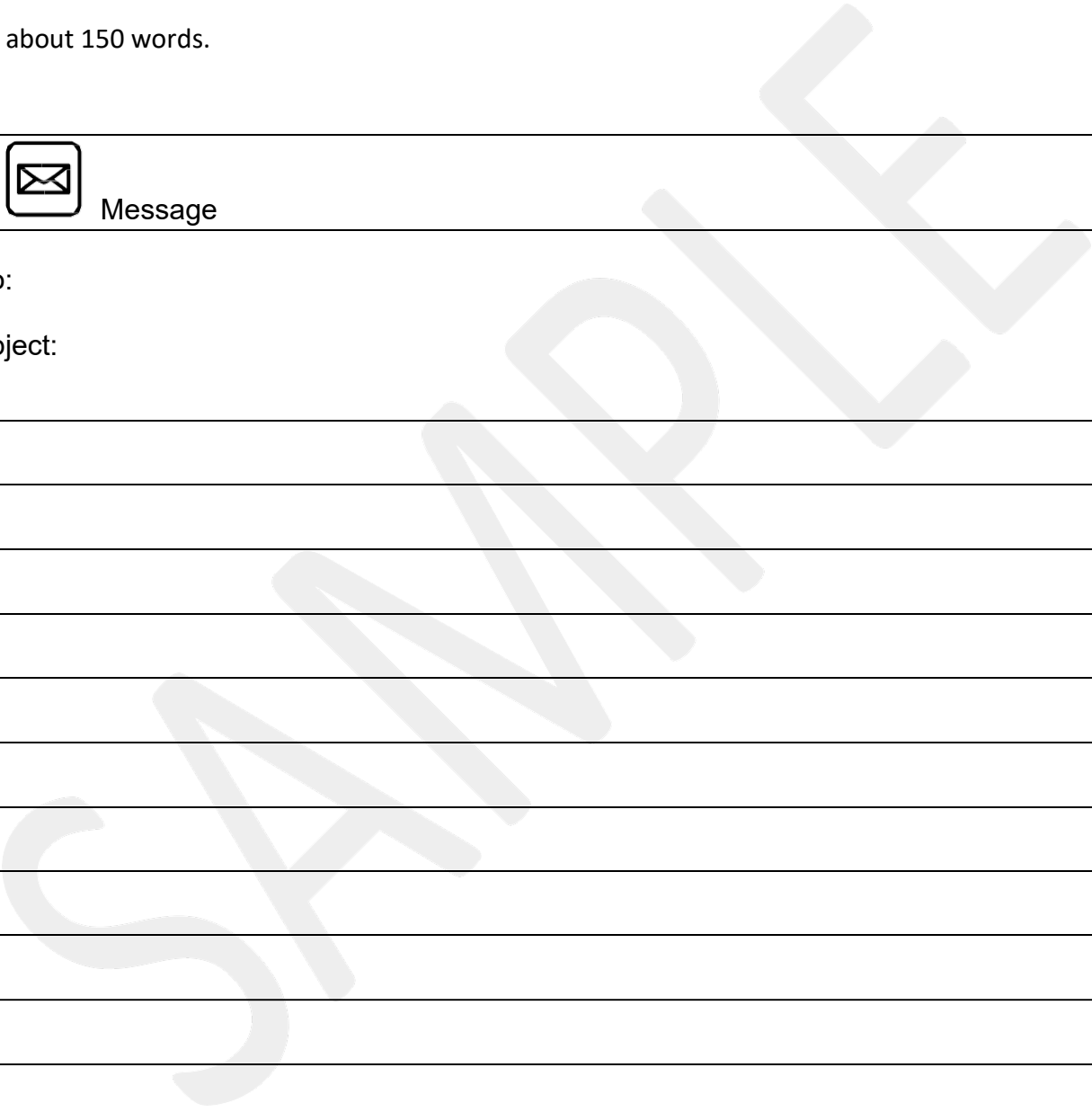
You read in your local newspaper that the council are proposing to stop the collection of recyclable waste e.g. paper, plastic, glass etc. from October 1st to March 1st.
