Transport Research Results

A **questionnaire** shows that the average daily journey to work in Britain is one hour and 38 minutes. For some people on the East Coast the journey can take longer, two hours and 25 minutes. Most people prefer to travel by train.

The most popular activities for travellers are:

- listening to music or a podcast
- watching a film
- making phone calls
- working on laptops

These activities are often annoying for other travellers. People report that the music is sometimes too loud and that travellers talk too loudly on their phones. Mobile phones ringing are a problem when others are trying to work or rest on long journeys.

The cost of travelling to work is different around the country but people in London spend about £176 a month. Travellers feel the train fares are too high and because of the high cost of living in London, they are encouraged to move further north to reduce costs. Houses are cheaper, travel is cheaper and so are the day to day living expenses in the north.

Birmingham has become popular for business. Some companies are moving there because **they** pay lower rent and get staff more easily.



What is your favourite fruit?

Mangoes



Mangoes are one of the most popular fruits in the world. They are full of flavour and are sometimes called a “super fruit”.

Mangoes are delicious and most people enjoy them. They came from India, but now we find them growing around the world in many continents.

Each fruit measures 5 to 15 cms in length and about 4 to 10 cms in width, and has an oval shape. It weighs from 150 gms to around 750 gms. The skin is smooth and is green before it is ready to eat. Mangoes then turn golden yellow, red or orange-red when they are ripe. The fresh mango season lasts from April until August.

Health benefits of Mangoes

- Mangoes can improve eye health.
- Mangoes can protect against some cancers.
- Fresh mango can help to control blood pressure.

Preparation and serving method

Wash mangoes in cold running water to remove dust and dirt. Dry using a soft cloth. Cut the fruit lengthwise into three pieces or cut on each side of the hard centre.

Enjoy your favourite mangoes in salads, chutneys, desserts and sauces.
