

## **Introduction to Entry Level Resource Pack**

Welcome to our new resource pack, designed to support our centres in their delivery of our Entry Level Awards in Speech.

Each of these qualifications consists of 4 core assessment sections:

1. A talk on a topic of the learners' choice
2. Introducing and speaking a poem or piece of drama by heart
3. Introducing a favourite novel or story and reading a section aloud to the group
4. Participating in a discussion, listening supportively, and asking and answering questions.
